Deferred Maintenance – Critical Hardship Grant – Roofing Replacement

Scheduled to replace approximately 43,000 sq. ft. (2,000 composition shingles and 41,000 of built-up roofing)

Felton Tri-Campus Infrastructure

- Wetlands Project - construct 5,000 gallon recirculation tank, a high rate trickling filter system, a 3,000 gallon second clarifier, a high rate rock trickling filter, and a wetlands system containing two wetland ponds
- Internet Connectivity and Servers at all Sites
- Additional Electrical Transformer at SLE – reduces electric load coming from MS
- Upgrade Septic Pumps – Replace septic tanks and retrofit current pumps
